BORROWING PLAYERS & FILL-INS

If teams require additional players please check the C&DNA By-Laws the current and update to rules. The below is a guide to allocating existing club players to play up or inviting external players to fill-in.

BORROWING A PLAYER (within the club)

- You may 'borrow' players from other Ormond teams as long as they are in a lower division or younger age group.
- One single player may only play up into the same team for four games, and can only play in two club games on the same day.
- Players in the 9/U division may borrow players from their own club age group within the same division.

Fill-in player (outside the club)

- A player, external to the Club, must be VNA registered, and will need to be added to the team in Netball Connect via a single game voucher provided by the Clubs Registration Officer.
- A fill-in player would need to comply with the age requirements of the team competition level.
- Players requiring a single game voucher should use this [club registration link](#) and complete their single game registration in Netball Connect.
- Fill-in player would use the club registration link to register, selecting the appropriate age/division for the team, selecting '**One Match Only**', and proceeding with payment.
- Once players have registered the, Team Manager, Coach or Scorer will then need to search their name and add them as a player to the team confirmation in **Netball Connect** before the game commences

Team Managers or Coaches must add borrowed or fill-in players to games in **Netball Connect** when confirming team players on game day. By doing this it ensures Netball Victoria insurance cover and maintains a record of player games for club presentation day.

Penalties will apply from CDNA if borrowed or fill-in players are not entered correctly.
